To ensure you are ready for the challenges of becoming a PADI Instructor, the following prerequisites are necessary:

- 💆 Minimum Age: You must be at least 18 years old to participate.
- © Certifications:
 - o Certified PADI Divemaster (or equivalent) for a minimum of six months.
 - Completed Emergency First Response Primary and Secondary Care training within the past 24 months.
- **Medical Statement:** A medical certificate signed by a licensed physician within the last 12 months (Download the PDF here for more details).
- **1** Logged Dives:
 - A minimum of 60 logged dives before starting the IDC training.
 - At least 100 logged dives required to attend the Instructor Examination (IE).
- **Z Duration:** The program includes a 15-day internship, offering immersive training to prepare you fully for a career in diving.

Social Visa for Dive Master Trainees

Joining our Dive Master training program? You'll need a Social Visa to stay in Indonesia for up to 6 months. Don't worry our trusted agent will handle the process for you, ensuring a hassle-free experience while you focus on your training!

Key Details:

- 📅 Initial validity: 60 days.
- 🔁 Extensions: Renewable up to 4 times, 30 days each, for a total stay of up to 180 days.

What Do You Need?

To get your Social Visa, you'll need:

- A valid passport (at least 6 months of validity).
- Letter of sponsorship: Provided by our agent.
- Return or onward flight ticket.
- Completed visa application form.
- Recent passport-sized photos.
- Visa fee: to be check directly with the legal agent,
